## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of a technology center grant program for
3	rural counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 487, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER P. RURAL TECHNOLOGY CENTER GRANT PROGRAM
8	Sec. 487.701. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "rural
9	border county" means a county that:
10	(1) is located within the South Texas region adjacent
11	to an international border; and
12	(2) has a population of not more than 75,000.
13	Sec. 487.702. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) Subject to available
14	funds, the executive committee shall establish a grant program
15	under which the office awards grants to public institutions of
16	higher education, public high schools, and governmental entities
17	located in a rural border county for the development and operation
18	of multi-institutional technology centers that provide:
19	(1) community access to technology;
20	(2) computer literacy programs;
21	(3) educational programs designed to provide
22	concurrent enrollment credit for high school students taking
23	postsecondary courses in information and emerging technologies;

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(4) training for careers in technology-related fields

1	and other highly skilled industries; and
2	(5) technology-related continuing and adult education
3	programs.
4	(b) The executive committee by rule shall establish:
5	(1) eligibility criteria for grant applicants;
6	(2) grant application procedures;
7	(3) guidelines relating to grant amounts;
8	(4) procedures for evaluating grant applications; and
9	(5) procedures for monitoring the use of grants
10	awarded under the program and for ensuring compliance with the
11	conditions of a grant.
12	Sec. 487.703. FUNDING. The office may seek, receive, and
13	spend money received through an appropriation, grant, donation, or
14	reimbursement from any public or private source to implement this
15	subchapter.
16	SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2007, the executive
17	committee of the Office of Rural Community Affairs shall establish
18	the rural technology center grant program required by Subchapter P,
19	Chapter 487, Government Code, as added by this Act, and the Office
20	of Rural Community Affairs shall award the first grants under that
21	program not later than January 1, 2008.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
25	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
26	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
