A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the adoption of a state scenic byways program. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 391, Transportation Code, 4 5 is amended by adding Section 391.038 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 391.038. REGULATION OF OUTDOOR ADVERTISING ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the commission 7 by rule shall prohibit outdoor advertising in a manner consistent 8 with 23 U.S.C. Section 131(s) on a State Scenic Byway designated 9 under Section 391.256. 10 11 (b) A rule adopted under Subsection (a) may not apply to outdoor advertising: 12 13 (1) permitted under Section 391.031(b)(1); or 14 (2) required to be relocated by an improvement to the state highway system if the advertising was erected before the 15 16 highway was designated a State Scenic Byway under Section 391.256. SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 391, Transportation Code, 17 is amended by adding Section 391.256 to read as follows: 18 Sec. 391.256. SCENIC BYWAYS PROGRAM. (a) The department 19 shall plan, design, and establish a program for designating 20 21 highways as State Scenic Byways. (b) The program must include a process by which the 22 23 department: 24 (1) receives proposals from political subdivisions or

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1	other community groups approved by the department for funding								
2	projects in accordance with 23 U.S.C. Section 162;								
3	(2) applies for grants under 23 U.S.C. Section 162 for								
4	the projects;								
5	(3) allows an applicant who consents to pay for the								
6	costs of the projects that are not covered by grants made under 23								
7	U.S.C. Section 162;								
8	(4) excludes from designation a highway or a segment								
9	of a highway that no longer meets the criteria established by the								
10	department for designation as a State Scenic Byway; and								
11	(5) excludes from designation as a State Scenic Byway								
12	any segment of a highway that:								
13	(A) is adjacent to land zoned as commercial or								
14	industrial;								
15	(B) does not have the scenic, historic, cultural,								
16	natural, recreational, or archaeological qualities for which the								
17	highway as a whole is being designated; and								
18	(C) is not requested to be excluded from								
19	designation for the sole purpose of allowing outdoor advertising as								
20	determined by the department.								
21	(c) The department shall designate a highway as a State								
22	Scenic Byway under the program established by this section before								
23	the department applies for a grant under Subsection (b)(2) for a								
24	project related to the highway.								
25	(d) The department may use money from the state highway fund								
26	to pay for the costs of a project that are not covered by a grant								
27	made under 23 U.S.C. Section 162.								

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1	(e) The	department	shall	adopt	rules	to	implement	this
2	section.								

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
