## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the cancellation of the voter registration of persons
- 3 who are deceased or not citizens of the United States.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 16.001(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Each month the local registrar of deaths shall prepare
- 8 an abstract of each death certificate issued in the month for a
- 9 decedent 18 years of age or older who was a resident of the state at
- 10 the time of death. The local registrar of deaths shall file each
- 11 abstract with the voter registrar of the decedent's county of
- 12 residence and the secretary of state not later than the 10th day of
- 13 the month following the month in which the abstract is prepared.
- 14 (b) Each month the clerk of each court having probate
- 15 jurisdiction shall prepare an abstract of each application for
- 16 probate of a will or administration of a decedent's estate filed in
- 17 the month with a court served by the clerk. The clerk shall file
- 18 each abstract with the voter registrar and the secretary of state
- 19 not later than the 10th day of the month following the month in
- 20 which the abstract is prepared.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 16.031(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (b) The registrar shall cancel a voter's registration
- 24 immediately if the registrar:

- 1 (1) determines from information received under
- 2 Section 16.001(c) that the voter is deceased;
- 3 (2) has personal knowledge that the voter is deceased;
- 4 [<del>or</del>]
- 5 (3) receives from a person related within the second
- 6 degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under Chapter
- 7 573, Government Code, to the voter a sworn statement by that person
- 8 indicating that the voter is deceased; or
- 9 (4) receives notice from the secretary of state under
- 10 Section 18.068 that the voter is deceased.
- SECTION 3. Section 16.0332(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (a) After the registrar receives a list under Section 18.068
- of this code or Section 62.113, Government Code, of persons excused
- or disqualified from jury service because of citizenship status,
- 16 the registrar shall deliver to each registered voter whose name
- 17 appears on the list a written notice requiring the voter to submit
- 18 to the registrar proof of United States citizenship in the form of a
- 19 certified copy of the voter's birth certificate, United States
- 20 passport, or certificate of naturalization or any other form
- 21 prescribed by the secretary of state. The notice shall be delivered
- 22 by forwardable mail to the mailing address on the voter's
- 23 registration application and to any new address of the voter known
- 24 to the registrar.
- 25 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 18, Election Code, is
- amended by adding Section 18.068 to read as follows:
- 27 Sec. 18.068. COMPARISON OF INFORMATION REGARDING

- 1 INELIGIBILITY. The secretary of state shall semiannually compare
- 2 the information received under Section 16.001 of this code and
- 3 Section 62.113, Government Code, to the statewide computerized
- 4 voter registration list. If the secretary determines that a voter
- 5 on the registration list is deceased or has been excused or
- 6 disqualified from jury service because the voter is not a citizen,
- 7 the secretary shall send notice of the determination to the voter
- 8 registrar of the counties considered appropriate by the secretary.
- 9 SECTION 5. Sections 62.113(b) and (c), Government Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (b) On the third business day of each month, the clerk shall
- send a copy of the list of persons excused or disqualified because
- of citizenship in the previous month to:
- 14 (1) the voter registrar of the county;
- 15 (2) the secretary of state; and
- 16 (3) the county or district attorney, as applicable,
- 17 for an investigation of whether the person committed an offense
- under Section 13.007, Election Code, or other law.
- 19 (c) A list compiled under this section may not be used for a
- 20 purpose other than a purpose described by Subsection (b) or Section
- 21 16.0332 <u>or 18.068</u>, Election Code.
- 22 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
