Section 552.301, Government Code, is amended by 6 7 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows: 8 (g) A governmental body may ask for another decision from 9 the attorney general concerning the precise information that was at issue in a prior decision made by the attorney general under this 10 11 subchapter if: 12 (1) a suit challenging the prior decision was timely 13 filed against the attorney general in accordance with this chapter 14 concerning the precise information at issue; 15 (2) the attorney general determines that the requestor has voluntarily withdrawn the request for the information in 16 writing or has abandoned the request; and 17 18 (3) the parties agree to dismiss the lawsuit. SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 552, Government Code, is 19 amended by adding Section 552.327 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 552.327. DISMISSAL OF SUIT DUE TO REQUESTOR'S WITHDRAWAL OR ABANDONMENT OF REQUEST. A court may dismiss a suit 22 23 challenging a decision of the attorney general brought in

accordance with this chapter if:
