4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.405 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 242.405. PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION FOR RESIDENTS. (a)
8	The department, with the assistance of physicians or other health
9	care providers experienced with the use of personal identification
10	devices, by rule shall specify a distinctive standard design for a
11	necklace and a bracelet personal identification device to be
12	provided to each resident. The department shall also specify by
13	<u>rule:</u>
14	(1) the type of information to be contained on the
15	device so that each resident may be easily identified; and
16	(2) the format and font style of the information.
17	(b) Not later than the 15th day after the date a resident has
18	entered an institution on a full-time basis, the institution shall
19	provide to the resident a personal identification device
20	personalized for the resident.
21	(c) The department shall ensure that rules adopted under
22	this section comply with the privacy rule of the Administrative
23	Simplification subtitle of the Health Insurance Portability and
24	Accountability Act of 1996 (Pub. L. No. 104-191) contained in 45

2	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
3	Code, is amended by adding Section 247.070 to read as follows:
4	Sec. 247.070. PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION FOR RESIDENTS. (a)
5	The department, with the assistance of physicians or other health
6	care providers experienced with the use of personal identification
7	devices, by rule shall specify a distinctive standard design for a
8	necklace and a bracelet personal identification device to be
9	provided to each resident of an assisted living facility. The
10	department shall also specify:
11	(1) the type of information to be contained on the
12	device so that each resident of an assisted living facility may be
13	easily identified; and
14	(2) the format and font style of the information.
15	(b) Not later than the 15th day after the date a resident has
16	entered an assisted living facility on a full-time basis, the
17	assisted living facility shall provide to the resident a personal
18	identification device personalized for the resident.
19	(c) The department shall ensure that rules adopted under
20	this section comply with the privacy rule of the Administrative
21	Simplification subtitle of the Health Insurance Portability and
22	Accountability Act of 1996 (Pub. L. No. 104-191) contained in 45
23	C.F.R. Part 160 and 45 C.F.R. Part 164, Subparts A and E.
24	SECTION 3. (a) Not later than December 1, 2007, the
25	executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
26	shall adopt the rules necessary to implement the changes in law made
27	by this Act to Chapters 242 and 247, Health and Safety Code.

(b) An institution as defined by Section 242.002, Health and
Safety Code, and an assisted living facility as defined by Section
247.002, Health and Safety Code, must provide a personalized
personal identification device developed in accordance with
Sections 242.405 and 247.070, Health and Safety Code, as added by
this Act, to each resident not later than March 1, 2008.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
