- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1702.184 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1702.184. LOCAL REGULATION OF CERTAIN SECURITY
- 8 SERVICES FOR PRIVATE BUSINESSES. (a) Except as provided by
- 9 Subsection (b), a political subdivision of this state may not
- 10 require a private business to contract with or employ a peace
- 11 officer to provide security services for the business.
- 12 (b) This section does not apply to:
- 13 <u>(1) a requirement that a private business contract</u>
- 14 with or employ a peace officer to provide security services for a
- public event, conduct a public escort, or direct traffic on a public
- 16 roadway; or
- 17 (2) an order or determination made by a court under
- 18 Chapter 125, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
