Sec. 43.150. 109TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT. [(a)] The voters of Crane and Winkler counties elect a district attorney for the 109th Judicial District who represents the state in that district court only in those counties.

15 [(b) The commissioners courts of the counties comprising 16 the district may supplement the state salary of the district 17 attorney in an amount not to exceed \$2,000 a year. Each 18 commissioners court shall pay a proportionate share of the 19 supplemental salary according to the population of the county.] 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
