5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide an
7	important new tool to assist in the prevention of automobile theft
8	and at the same time to ensure that the services of registered
9	locksmiths are used in a manner that safeguards the privacy and
10	security of owners and lessees of passenger cars in this state.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter J, Chapter 2301, Occupations Code, is
12	amended by adding Section 2301.479 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 2301.479. MOTOR VEHICLE ACCESS INFORMATION. (a) In
14	this section:
15	(1) "Access information" means the information
16	necessary for a locksmith to allow an owner to enter, start, and

1	(b) This section applies:
2	(1) only to a motor vehicle, other than a motorcycle,
3	used to transport persons and designed to accommodate 10 or fewer
4	passengers, including the operator;
5	(2) only to a new motor vehicle sold or leased in this
6	state on or after September 1, 2008; and
7	(3) in a calendar year only to a make of motor vehicle
8	of which 1,000 or more motor vehicles were sold or leased in this
9	state in the preceding calendar year.
10	(c) A manufacturer shall issue a registration number and
11	security password to each locksmith that applies to the
12	manufacturer for a registration number.
13	(d) A manufacturer shall provide access information at any
14	time by telephone or electronically to a locksmith who:
15	(1) provides the locksmith's registration number
16	issued by the manufacturer;
17	(2) provides the locksmith's security password issued
18	by the manufacturer;
19	(3) confirms that the locksmith has complied with the
20	requirements of Section 1702.286, as added by Chapter 1102, Acts of
21	the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005;
22	(4) provides the vehicle identification number and
23	model number of the motor vehicle for which the locksmith is seeking
24	access information; and
25	(5) complies with other reasonable authentication
26	measures adopted by the manufacturer.
27	(e) A manufacturer that complies with Subsection (d) is not

1	liable for the theft of the motor vehicle for which the manufacturer
2	provided access information.
3	(f) Before requesting access information from a
4	manufacturer, a locksmith must follow the procedures under Section
5	1702.286, as added by Chapter 1102, Acts of the 79th Legislature,
6	Regular Session, 2005. After producing a replacement key or
7	otherwise providing the owner access to a passenger car, the
8	locksmith shall provide the access information to the owner and
9	destroy any access information in the locksmith's possession. A
10	locksmith who complies with this subsection is not liable for the
11	theft of the motor vehicle, except in the event of fraud or
12	misappropriation of access information by the locksmith.
13	(g) A manufacturer shall retain and make available under
14	Subsection (d) access information for a motor vehicle to which this
15	section applies for at least 25 years after the date the motor
16	vehicle is manufactured.
17	(h) A manufacturer may perform the duties required of the
18	manufacturer under this section directly or through an agent under
19	a contract.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
