## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain requirements for the issuance and renewal of a 3 salvage vehicle dealer license.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2302.104, Occupations Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(d) In addition to the other requirements for issuance of a</u> 8 <u>license, an applicant who is classified as a used vehicle parts</u>
- 9 <u>dealer</u>, salvage vehicle broker, or salvage vehicle rebuilder must
- 10 provide proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
- 11 <u>holds a current storm water permit issued by the Texas Commission on</u>
- 12 <u>Environmental Quality.</u>
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 2302, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 2302.154 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 2302.154. STORM WATER PERMIT REQUIRED FOR RENEWAL. In
- 16 addition to the other requirements for renewal of a license, a
- 17 license holder who is classified as a used vehicle parts dealer,
- 18 salvage vehicle broker, or salvage vehicle rebuilder must provide
- 19 proof satisfactory to the department that the license holder holds
- 20 <u>a current storm water permit issued by the Texas Commission on</u>
- 21 Environmental Quality.
- 22 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act by the
- enactment of Section 2302.104(d), Occupations Code, applies to an
- 24 application for a license under Chapter 2302, Occupations Code,

- 1 that is filed on or after January 1, 2008. A license application
- 2 filed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date
- 3 the application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 4 for that purpose.
- 5 (b) The change in law made by this Act by the enactment of
- 6 Section 2302.154, Occupations Code, applies to the renewal of a
- 7 license that expires under Chapter 2302, Occupations Code, on or
- 8 after January 1, 2008. A license that expires before that date is
- 9 governed by the law in effect on the date the license expired, and
- 10 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 (c) The Texas Transportation Commission shall raise
- 12 application and renewal fees under Section 2302.052, Occupations
- 13 Code, as necessary to cover the costs of administering the changes
- in law made by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
