4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate
8	criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess
9	essential knowledge and skills in reading, writing, mathematics,
10	social studies, and science. All students, except students
11	assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section
12	39.027, shall be assessed in:
13	(1) mathematics annually in grades three through

- 13 (1) mathematics, annually in grades three through 14 seven without the aid of technology and in grades eight through 11 15 with the aid of technology on any assessment instruments that 16 include algebra;
- 17 (2) reading, annually in grades three through nine;
- 18 (3) writing, including spelling and grammar, in grades
- 19 four and seven;
- 20 (4) English language arts, in grade 10;
- 21 (5) social studies:
- 22 (A) including Texas history, in grade [grades]
- 23 eight; and
- 24 (B) in grade 10;

- 1 (6) science, in grades five, eight, and 10; and
- 2 (7) any other subject and grade required by federal
- 3 law.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2008-2009
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
