H.B. No. 2345

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Texas Organic Agricultural Industry  
Advisory Board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Title 3, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding  
Chapter 50C to read as follows:

CHAPTER 50C. TEXAS ORGANIC AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 50C.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "board" means  
the Texas Organic Agricultural Industry Advisory Board.

Sec. 50C.002. COMPOSITION. (a) The board is composed of the  
following 11 members appointed by the commissioner:

(1) four members who produce organic agricultural  
products;

(2) two members who are retail sellers of organic  
agricultural products;

(3) one member who distributes organic agricultural  
products;

(4) one member who processes organic agricultural  
products;

(5) one member who represents a trade association that  
represents the organic agricultural industry;

(6) one member who represents the public; and

(7) one representative from the department.

(b) The board shall elect a presiding officer from among its

2 (c) Members of the board serve staggered terms of four  
3 years, with either five or six members' terms, as applicable,  
4 expiring February 1 of each odd-numbered year. Members may be  
5 reappointed at the end of a term.

6 (d) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the  
7 size, composition, or duration of the board.

8 (e) Service on the board by a state officer or employee is an  
9 additional duty of the member's office or employment. Members of  
10 the board are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement of  
11 expenses.

12 Sec. 50C.003. DUTIES. The board shall:

13 (1) assist the department in:

14 (A) assessing the state of the organic  
15 agricultural products industry in this state;

16 (B) developing recommendations to the  
17 commissioner and the legislature to promote and expand the organic  
18 agricultural products industry in this state;

19 (C) identifying and obtaining grants and gifts to  
20 promote and expand the organic agricultural products industry in  
21 this state; and

22 (D) developing a statewide organic agricultural  
23 products education and awareness campaign, utilizing the Texas  
24 Cooperative Extension's educational programs and channels of  
25 distribution when appropriate; and

26 (2) review and provide guidance on rules impacting the  
27 organic agricultural products industry in this state.

1       Sec. 50C.004 MEETINGS. The board shall meet at least once  
2 each year and may meet at other times considered necessary by the  
3 commissioner.

4       Sec. 50C.005. STAFF. The board is administratively  
5 attached to the department. The department shall provide the board  
6 with the staff necessary to carry out its duties under this chapter.

7       SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
