- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.13(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, a
- 8 person who is within the fourth degree by consanguinity or affinity
- 9 of a licensee or permittee, as determined under Chapter 573,
- 10 Government Code, whose license or permit was canceled under Section
- 11 11.61 or 61.71 may not, for a period of three [two] years from the
- 12 date of the cancellation, apply for a license or permit in
- 13 connection with an establishment at the same location as the
- 14 establishment whose license or permit was canceled.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an application for an alcoholic beverage permit or license
- 17 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 18 application submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
