- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.44, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.44. PREMISES INELIGIBLE FOR PERMIT OR LICENSE. (a)
- 8 If an order of suspension against a permit or license is pending or
- 9 unexpired, or if the commission has initiated action to cancel or
- 10 suspend a permit or license, no permit or license may be issued for
- or transferred to the same licensed premises.
- 12 (b) The commission or administrator shall refuse to issue
- for a period of three years a permit or license for any location to
- 14 an applicant who submitted a prior application that expired or was
- voluntarily surrendered before the hearing on the application was
- 16 held on a protest involving allegations of prostitution, a
- 17 shooting, stabbing, or other violent act, or an offense involving
- 18 drugs. The three-year period commences on the date the prior
- 19 application expired or was voluntarily surrendered.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an application for a license or permit submitted on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act, regardless of the date on which a
- 23 previous application expired or surrendered. An application
- 24 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the

- 2 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
