- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1001.053, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1001.053. PUBLIC WORKS. The following work is exempt
- 9 from this chapter:
- 10 (1) a public work that involves electrical or
- 11 mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense for the
- 12 completed project is \$8,000 or less;
- 13 (2) a public work that does not involve electrical or
- 14 mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense for the
- completed project is \$20,000 or less; or
- 16 (3) road <u>or bridge</u> maintenance or improvement
- 17 undertaken by the commissioners court of a county.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
