

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the board of navigation and canal
3 commissioners of the Victoria County Navigation District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 5, Special District Local Laws
6 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 5005 to read as follows:

7 CHAPTER 5005. VICTORIA COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT

8 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

9 Sec. 5005.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

10 (1) "Board" means the board of navigation and canal
11 commissioners of the Victoria County Navigation District.

12 (2) "District" means the Victoria County Navigation
13 District.

15 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD

16 Sec. 5005.051. COMPOSITION OF BOARD. The district is
17 governed by a board of five navigation and canal commissioners
18 appointed by the Commissioners Court of Victoria County.

19 SECTION 2. (a) A navigation and canal commissioner of the
20 Victoria County Navigation District serving on the effective date
21 of this Act continues to serve until the expiration of the term for
22 which the commissioner was appointed.

23 (b) The Commissioners Court of Victoria County shall make
24 appointments to the board of navigation and canal commissioners of

1 the Victoria County Navigation District to achieve, as soon as
2 practicable, the composition prescribed by Section 5005.051,
3 Special District Local Laws Code, as added by this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
