- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 504.408, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 504.408. GOLD STAR MOTHER, SPOUSE, OR FAMILY MEMBER
- 9 [MOTHERS].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 504.408, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 (a) The department shall issue a specialty license plate
- 14 [plates] for the mother, surviving spouse, or immediate family
- 15 member of a person who died while serving in the United States armed
- 16 forces. License plates issued under this section must include the
- words "Gold Star Mother," "Gold Star Spouse," or "Gold Star Family"
- 18 and a gold star. A person may not be issued more than one set of the
- 19 license plates at a time.
- 20 <u>(a-1)</u> In this section "immediate family member" means the
- 21 parent, child, or sibling of a person who died while serving in the
- 22 United States armed forces.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
