5	SECTION 1. Chapter 209, Property Code, is amended by adding

- Sec. 209.012. RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS GRANTING EASEMENTS TO CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATIONS. (a) A property owners' association may not amend a dedicatory instrument to grant the property owners' association an easement through or over an owner's lot without the consent of the owner.
- 12 <u>(b) This section does not prohibit a property owners'</u>
  13 <u>association from adopting or enforcing a restriction in a</u>
  14 <u>dedicatory instrument that allows the property owners' association</u>
  15 to access an owner's lot to:
- 16 (1) remedy a violation of the dedicatory instrument;
  17 or
- 18 <u>(2) take any other enforcement action related to a</u>
  19 violation of the dedicatory instrument.
- SECTION 2. Section 209.012, Property Code, as added by this
  Act, applies only to an easement granted by a dedicatory instrument
  on or after the effective date of this Act. An easement granted by a
  dedicatory instrument before the effective date of this Act is
  governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
