## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to state funding for annual stipends provided to public
- 3 school teachers who serve as mentors to other public school
- 4 teachers.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 21.458, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (c-1), (c-2), and
- 8 (c-3) to read as follows:
- 9 (c) From the funds allocated under Section 21.703 or other
- 10 funds appropriated to the agency for purposes of this section, the
- 11 commissioner shall adopt rules and provide funding to school
- 12 districts that assign mentor teachers under this section. Funding
- 13 provided to districts under this section may be used only for
- 14 providing:
- 15 (1) mentor teacher stipends in the amount of \$2,000
- 16 per teacher for each school year during which the teacher serves as
- 17 <u>a mentor</u>;
- 18 (2) scheduled time for mentor teachers to provide
- 19 mentoring to assigned classroom teachers; and
- 20 (3) mentoring support through providers of mentor
- 21 training.
- 22 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a school district may
- 23 use funds provided under that subsection for a purpose authorized
- 24 by Subsection (c)(2) or (3) only to the extent that funds remain

- 1 after fully funding the stipends authorized by Subsection (c)(1).
- 2 <u>(c-2)</u> Subsection (c-1) does not create a property right of a
- 3 teacher to receive a stipend. If a school district receives
- 4 insufficient funds to fully fund the stipends, the district shall
- 5 reduce the stipend the district pays to each teacher serving as a
- 6 mentor proportionately so that each teacher serving as a mentor
- 7 receives the same amount of money.
- 8 <u>(c-3)</u> A stipend a teacher receives under this section is not
- 9 considered in determining whether the district is paying the
- teacher the minimum monthly salary under Section 21.402.
- SECTION 2. Sections 21.703(a), (b), and (d), Education
- 12 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) Each state fiscal year, the commissioner shall deposit
- 14 the sum of \$1,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers in
- 15 this state to the credit of the educator excellence fund in the
- 16 general revenue fund. Each state fiscal year, the agency shall use:
- 17 (1) from the funds in the educator excellence fund,
- 18 the amount necessary to fund stipends under Section 21.458 for
- 19 <u>teachers who serve as mentors to other teachers, provided that not</u>
- 20 more than \$150 million may be used for this purpose each fiscal
- 21 <u>year;</u>
- 22 (2) not more than \$100 million of any remaining [the]
- 23 funds in the educator excellence fund to provide grant awards under
- 24 the awards for student achievement program established under
- 25 Subchapter N; and
- (3)  $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$  any remaining funds in the educator
- 27 excellence fund to provide a qualifying school district a grant in

- 1 an amount determined by:
- 2 (A) dividing the amount of remaining money
- 3 available for distribution in the educator excellence fund by the
- 4 total number of students in average daily attendance in qualifying
- 5 districts for that fiscal year; and
- 6 (B) multiplying the amount determined under
- 7 Paragraph (A) by the number of students in average daily attendance
- 8 in the district.
- 9 (b) Subsection (a) applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 10 year beginning September 1, 2008. In the state fiscal year
- 11 beginning September 1, 2007, the commissioner shall deposit \$840
- 12 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers in this state to the
- 13 credit of the educator excellence fund in the general revenue fund.
- 14 The agency shall use:
- 15 (1) <u>from the funds in the educator excellence fund</u>,
- 16 the amount necessary to fund stipends under Section 21.458 for
- 17 teachers who serve as mentors to other teachers, provided that not
- more than \$150 million may be used for this purpose;
- 19 (2) not more than \$100 million of any remaining [the]
- 20 funds in the educator excellence fund to provide grant awards under
- 21 the awards for student achievement program established under
- 22 Subchapter N; and
- (3)  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  any remaining funds in the educator
- 24 excellence fund to provide a qualifying school district a grant in
- 25 an amount determined by:
- 26 (A) dividing the amount of remaining money
- 27 available for distribution in the educator excellence fund by the

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- 1 total number of students in average daily attendance in qualifying
- 2 districts for that fiscal year; and
- 3 (B) multiplying the amount determined under
- 4 Paragraph (A) by the number of students in average daily attendance
- 5 in the district.
- 6 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) or (b), the agency may
- 7 use funds in the educator excellence fund remaining after
- 8 compliance with Subsection (a)(1) or (b)(1), as applicable, as
- 9 necessary to conduct or contract with another entity to conduct the
- 10 evaluation required under Section 21.706. This subsection expires
- 11 June 1, 2011.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
