2 relating to the requirement that the chief appraiser of an 3 appraisal district provide an estimate of taxable value and related 4 assistance to certain taxing units.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.01(e), Tax Code, is amended to read as 7 follows:

(e) By June 7, the chief appraiser shall prepare and certify 8 to the assessor for each county, municipality, and school district 9 participating in the appraisal district an estimate of the taxable 10 11 value of [school district] property in that taxing unit. The chief 12 appraiser shall assist each county, municipality, and school district in determining values of [school district] property in 13 14 that taxing unit for the taxing unit's [school district's] budgetary purposes. 15

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a tax year that begins on or after the effective date of this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2008.

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
