- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1071.253(c), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The board shall issue a surveyor-in-training
- 8 certificate to an applicant who passes the applicable parts of the
- 9 examination taken under Subsection (b). The certificate is valid
- 10 until [the earlier of:
- 11 [(1) the sixth anniversary of the date of issuance; or
- 12 $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ the date the certificate holder becomes
- 13 registered as a registered professional land surveyor.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 1071.305, Occupations Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 16 (d) As a condition for retaining a surveyor-in-training
- 17 certificate, the board shall require the certificate holder to
- 18 <u>successfully complete continuing professional education courses as</u>
- 19 prescribed by board rule. The certificate holder shall maintain
- 20 records relating to the person's professional education
- 21 <u>activities</u>. The records are subject to audit by the board as a
- 22 condition for retaining the certificate.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act by the
- 24 amendment of Sections 1071.253 and 1071.305, Occupations Code,

- 1 apply to a person who holds a surveyor-in-training certificate
- 2 under Chapter 1071, Occupations Code, on the effective date of this
- 3 Act or is issued a certificate on or after that date.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
