2	relating to the filing of financial statements by justices of the
3	peace and candidates for justice of the peace in certain counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 159.003, Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 159.003. FINANCIAL STATEMENT REQUIRED. (a) A county
8	officer <u>,</u> [or a] candidate for a county office <u>, justice of the peace,</u>
9	or candidate for the office of justice of the peace shall file a
10	financial statement as required by this subchapter.
11	(b) The statement must:
12	(1) be filed with the county clerk of the county in
13	which the officer, justice, or candidate resides; and
14	(2) comply with Sections 572.022 and 572.023,
15	Government Code.
16	SECTION 2. Sections 159.004(a), (c), and (d), Local
17	Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
18	(a) A county officer <u>or justice of the peace</u> shall file the
19	financial statement required by this subchapter within the time
20	prescribed by Section 572.026, Government Code. A candidate for
21	office as a county officer or justice of the peace shall file the
22	financial statement required by this subchapter within the time
23	prescribed by Section 572.027, Government Code.
24	(c) A county officer or justice of the peace may request the

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county clerk to grant an extension of time of not more than 60 days for filing the statement. The county clerk shall grant the request if it is received before the filing deadline or if a timely filing or request for extension is prevented because of physical or mental incapacity. The county clerk may not grant more than one extension to a person in one year except for good cause shown.

7 (d) The county clerk may not grant an extension to a
8 candidate for office as a county officer <u>or justice of the peace</u>.

9 SECTION 3. Section 159.007(c), Local Government Code, is10 amended to read as follows:

(c) The county clerk may, and on notification from a former <u>county</u> officer, justice of the peace, or candidate shall, destroy any financial statements filed by the officer, justice, or candidate two years after the date the person ceases to be an officer, justice, or candidate, as applicable.

SECTION 4. Section 159.0071, Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 159.0071. NOTIFICATION TO PROSECUTING ATTORNEY. 18 The county clerk of each county shall maintain a list of the county 19 officers, [and] candidates for county office, justices of the 20 peace, and candidates for the office of justice of the peace 21 required to file a financial statement under this subchapter. Not 22 later than the 10th day after each applicable filing deadline, the 23 24 county clerk shall provide to the county attorney or criminal 25 district attorney a copy of the list showing for each county officer, [and] candidate for county office, justice of the peace, 26 and candidate for justice of the peace: 27

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(1) whether the officer, justice, or candidate timely
 filed a financial statement as required by this subchapter;

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3 (2) whether the officer<u>, justice</u>, or candidate timely 4 requested and was granted an extension of time to file as provided 5 for by Section 159.004 and the new due date for each such officer<u>,</u> 6 justice, or candidate; or

7 (3) whether the officer, justice, or candidate did not
8 timely file a financial statement or receive an extension of time.

9 SECTION 5. Sections 159.008(a) and (c), Local Government 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) A county officer, [or a] candidate for county office, justice of the peace, or candidate for the office of justice of the peace commits an offense if the officer, justice, or candidate knowingly fails to file a financial statement as required by this subchapter.

16 (c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that 17 the officer<u>, justice</u>, or candidate did not receive copies of the 18 financial statement form required to be mailed to the officer<u>,</u> 19 <u>justice</u>, or candidate by this subchapter.

SECTION 6. A justice of the peace or a candidate for that office on the effective date of this Act must file the financial statement required for county officers under Subchapter A, Chapter 159, Local Government Code, as amended by this Act, on the first applicable financial statement filing deadline that occurs after the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
