A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the requirements for certification to provide training
3 to an owner of an on-site sewage disposal system using aerobic
4 treatment in maintaining the system.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 366.0515, Health and Safety Code, is
7 amended by amending Subsections (a) and (g) as follows:

8 (a) An authorized agent or the commission may not condition
9 a permit or the approval of a permit for an on-site sewage disposal
10 system using aerobic treatment for a single-family residence
11 located in a county with a population of less than 40,000 on the
12 system's owner contracting for the maintenance of the system.

13 (g) The owner of a single-family residence located in a
14 county with a population of less than 40,000 shall maintain the
15 system directly or through a maintenance contract. [~~The commission~~
16 ~~shall adopt rules governing:~~

17 [~~(1) the training in system maintenance to be provided~~
18 ~~to an owner who elects to maintain the system directly; and~~

19 [~~(2) the maintenance of a system by the owner of the~~
20 ~~system.~~]

21 SECTION 2. Section 366.0515, Health and Safety Code, is
22 amended by deleting Subsections (h), (i), (j), (n), and (o).

23 SECTION 3. Section 366.071(d), Health and Safety Code, as
24 repealed by Acts 2005, 79th Leg., ch. 1129, Sec. 4 is reinstated.

1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
