BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 419.054(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The funds allocation advisory committee is composed of six members. $\underline{\text{Two}}$ [Three] members are appointed by the State Firemen's and Fire Marshals' Association of Texas. $\underline{\text{Two}}$ [Three] members are appointed by the Texas State Association of Fire Fighters. $\underline{\text{Two}}$ members are appointed by the Texas Fire Chiefs Association. A committee member is subject to removal by the commission. A vacancy on the committee caused by removal of a member by the commission shall be filled by the authority that appointed the member who was removed.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
