A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the Texas Education Agency's online clearinghouse of
- 3 information concerning best practices for public schools and
- 4 open-enrollment charter schools.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 7.009, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 7.009. BEST PRACTICES; CLEARINGHOUSE. (a) In
- 9 coordination with the Legislative Budget Board, the agency shall
- 10 establish an online clearinghouse of information relating to best
- 11 practices of campuses, [and] school districts, and open-enrollment
- 12 <u>charter schools</u> regarding instruction, public school finance,
- 13 resource allocation, and business practices. To the extent
- 14 practicable, the agency shall ensure that information provided
- 15 through the online clearinghouse is specific, actionable
- 16 information relating to the best practices of high-performing and
- 17 highly efficient campuses, [and] school districts, and
- 18 open-enrollment charter schools rather than general guidelines
- 19 relating to campus, [and] school district, and open-enrollment
- 20 <u>charter school</u> operation. The information must be accessible by
- 21 campuses, school districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and
- 22 interested members of the public.
- 23 (b) The agency shall solicit and collect from the
- 24 Legislative Budget Board, centers for education research

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established under Section 1.005, [and] exemplary or recognized 1 2 school districts, campuses, and open-enrollment charter schools, as rated under Section 39.072, and campuses, school districts, and 3 open-enrollment charter schools identified under Subsection (c-1) 4 5 examples of best practices relating to instruction, public school 6 finance, resource allocation, and business practices, including 7 best practices relating to curriculum, scope and sequence, 8 compensation and incentive systems, bilingual education and special language programs, compensatory education programs, and 9 10 the effective use of instructional technology, including online 11 courses.

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- (c) The agency shall contract for the services of one or more third-party contractors to develop, implement, and maintain a system of collecting and evaluating the best practices of campuses, [and] school districts, and open-enrollment charter schools as provided by this section. In addition to any other considerations required by law, the agency must consider an applicant's demonstrated competence and qualifications in analyzing campus, [and] school district, and open-enrollment charter school practices in awarding a contract under this subsection.
- 21 <u>(c-1)</u> The system developed under Subsection (c) must be
 22 <u>capable of evaluating campuses, school districts, and</u>
 23 <u>open-enrollment charter schools using statistical analyses of</u>
 24 <u>performance data of campuses, school districts, and</u>
 25 <u>open-enrollment charter schools of similar demographics and</u>
 26 <u>identify those campuses, school districts, and open-enrollment</u>
 27 charter schools that are high-performing and highly efficient. The

- 1 information described by this subsection must be accessible by
- 2 <u>campuses</u>, school districts, and open-enrollment charter schools
- 3 and presented in a manner that is clear and easy to understand.
- 4 (d) The commissioner may purchase from available funds
- 5 curriculum and other instructional or analytical tools identified
- 6 under this section to provide for use by school districts and
- 7 open-enrollment charter schools.
- 8 <u>(e) Regional education service centers shall assist school</u>
- 9 districts and open-enrollment charter schools in:
- 10 <u>(1) using any instructional or analytical tools</u>
- 11 provided by the commissioner under Subsection (d); and
- 12 (2) implementing best practices included in the online
- 13 clearinghouse under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
