## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the Jim Wells County Juvenile Board.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 152.0032, Human Resources Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 152.0032. COMPOSITION OF JUVENILE BOARD. (a) The
- 7 juvenile board is composed of the county judge, the district judges
- 8 in the county, and the judges of any statutory courts designated as
- 9 a juvenile court in the county.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the juvenile board of
- 11 Jim Wells County is composed of the judges of the county and
- 12 district courts in the county. The board must have not fewer than
- 13 three nor more than five members. The judges of the county and
- 14 district courts in the county may appoint an appropriate number of
- 15 public members to serve on the board if necessary to satisfy this
- 16 requirement. Notwithstanding Section 152.0034(b), a public member
- 17 serves without compensation. The chairman of the board shall
- determine the number of public members to be appointed to the board.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
