1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the composition of the Jim Wells County Juvenile Board.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 152.0032, Human Resources Code, is
1-11 amended to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 152.0032. COMPOSITION OF JUVENILE BOARD. (a) The
1-13 juvenile board is composed of the county judge, the district judges
1-14 in the county, and the judges of any statutory courts designated as
1-15 a juvenile court in the county.

1-16 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the juvenile board of
1-17 Jim Wells County is composed of the judges of the county and
1-18 district courts in the county. The board must have not fewer than
1-19 three nor more than five members. The judges of the county and
1-20 district courts in the county may appoint an appropriate number of
1-21 public members to serve on the board if necessary to satisfy this
1-22 requirement. Notwithstanding Section 152.0034(b), a public member
1-23 serves without compensation. The chairman of the board shall
1-24 determine the number of public members to be appointed to the board.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
