1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the authority of the Denton County Municipal Utility  
1-10 District No. 6 to divide into two districts.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 8126, Special District  
1-13 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 8126.107 to read as  
1-14 follows:

1-15 Sec. 8126.107. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may  
1-16 be divided into two new districts only if the district:

1-17 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

1-18 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

1-19 (b) The division procedure is prescribed by Sections 53.030  
1-20 through 53.041, Water Code.

1-21 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district  
1-22 has all the powers and duties of the district.

1-23 (d) Any new district created by the division of the district  
1-24 may not contain any land outside the area described by Section 2,  
1-25 Chapter 774, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
