## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to prevention of discrimination and harassment in public
3	schools.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 11.171 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.171. DISCRIMINATION, HARASSMENT, AND RETALIATION
8	PROHIBITED. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Gender identity or expression" means a person's
10	having, or being perceived as having, a gender-related identity,
11	appearance, expression, or behavior, whether or not that identity,
12	appearance, expression, or behavior is different from that commonly
13	associated with the person's assigned sex at birth.
14	(2) "Sexual orientation" means heterosexuality,
15	homosexuality, or bisexuality.
16	(b) A school district or employee of a school district may
17	<pre>not:</pre>
18	(1) discriminate against or harass an employee of the
19	district or a student enrolled in the district on account of:
20	(A) the actual or perceived ethnicity, color,

or student's parent; or

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gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation,

disability, religion, or national origin of the employee, student,

(B) one or more persons with whom the employee,

- 1 student, or student's parent associates; or
- 2 (2) retaliate against an employee of the district or a
- 3 student enrolled in the district for reporting potential
- 4 discrimination or harassment prohibited by Subdivision (1).
- 5 (c) This section applies to conduct that occurs:
- 6 (1) on school property;
- 7 (2) while attending a school-sponsored or
- 8 school-related activity on or off of school property; or
- 9 (3) in connection with transportation of students in a
- vehicle owned or operated by a school district or owned or operated
- 11 by <u>another entity under contract with a school district.</u>
- 12 (d) A school district shall provide periodic training to
- 13 district employees regarding prevention of discrimination and
- 14 harassment prohibited by this section and procedures for responding
- to reported or observed incidents of prohibited discrimination or
- 16 harassment. The training may be provided in conjunction with any
- 17 training provided under Section 37.083.
- (e) In accordance with rules adopted by the commissioner,
- 19 each school district shall report annually to the agency
- 20 information regarding each incident of alleged discrimination or
- 21 harassment that occurred in the district during the preceding year.
- 22 The agency shall include the information in the comprehensive
- annual report required by Section 39.182.
- 24 SECTION 2. (a) Each school district shall submit to the
- 25 Texas Education Agency information as required under Section
- 26 11.171(e), Education Code, as added by this Act, beginning with the
- 27 2008-2009 school year based on incidents of discrimination or

- 1 harassment during the 2007-2008 school year.
- 2 (b) The Texas Education Agency shall include the
- 3 information required under Section 11.171(e), Education Code, as
- 4 added by this Act, in the comprehensive annual report required by
- 5 Section 39.182, Education Code, beginning with the report required
- 6 to be submitted not later than December 1, 2008.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
