A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the membership and duties of the Public Safety

- 3 Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 411.003(b), (c), and (d), Government
- 6 Code are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission is composed of <u>five</u> [three] citizens of
- 8 this state appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of
- 9 the senate. Members must be selected because of their peculiar
- 10 qualifications for the position [-] and must reflect the diverse
- 11 geographic regions <u>and population groups of this state.</u>
- 12 Appointments to the commission shall be made without regard to
- 13 race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or national origin.
- 14 In making an appointment the governor shall consider, among other
- 15 things, the person's knowledge of laws, experience in the
- 16 enforcement of law, honesty, integrity, education, training, and
- 17 executive ability.
- 18 (c) Members serve staggered six-year terms with the <u>terms</u>
- 19 [term] of either one or two members [member] expiring January 1 of
- 20 each even-numbered year.
- 21 (d) The governor shall designate one member of the
- 22 commission as chairman of the commission to serve in that capacity
- 23 at the pleasure of the governor. The commission shall meet at the
- 24 times and places specified by commission rule or at the call of the

- 1 chairman [or any two members]. The chairman shall oversee the
- 2 preparation of an agenda for each meeting and ensure that a copy is
- 3 provided to each member at least seven days before the meeting.
- 4 SECTION 2. Promptly after this Act takes effect, the
- 5 governor shall appoint two additional members to the Public Safety
- 6 Commission. Of those members, the governor shall designate one to
- 7 serve a term expiring January 1, 2010, and one to serve a term
- 8 expiring February 1, 2012.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
