AN ACT

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 1131.802, Insurance Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 1131.802. EXTENSION OF GROUP LIFE INSURANCE TO SPOUSES
7	AND CHILDREN; ELIGIBLE CHILDREN. Insurance under a group life
8	insurance policy may be extended to cover:
9	(1) the spouse of each individual eligible to be
10	insured under the policy; [ <del>or</del> ]
11	(2) a natural or adopted child of each individual
12	eligible to be insured under the policy if the child is:
13	(A) <u>unmarried; and</u> [ <del>younger than 21 years of age;</del>
14	or]
15	(B) <u>younger</u> [ <del>older</del> ] than <u>25</u> [ <del>21</del> ] years of age; or
16	(C) physically or mentally disabled and under the
17	<pre>parents' supervision; or</pre>
18	(3) a natural or adopted grandchild of each individual
19	eligible to be insured under the policy if the child is:
20	(A) unmarried;
21	(B) younger than 25 years of age; and
22	(C) a dependent of the insured for federal income
23	tax purposes at the time the application for coverage of the
24	grandchild is made [and:

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- [(i) enrolled as a full-time student at an educational institution; or

  [(ii) physically or mentally disabled and under the parents' supervision].
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
