- 2 relating to authorized investments in securities or property for
- 3 foreign companies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 982.105(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A foreign or alien life insurance company, accident
- 8 insurance company, life and accident insurance company, health and
- 9 accident insurance company, or life, health, and accident insurance
- 10 company is subject to Sections 422.051(a), 841.054, 841.201,
- 11 841.204, 841.205, 841.207, 841.301, and 841.302. The department
- 12 may not issue a certificate of authority to a foreign or alien stock
- insurance company, and the company may not engage in any business of
- 14 life, health, or accident insurance in this state, unless the
- 15 company possesses at least the minimum capital and surplus required
- 16 for a similar domestic insurance company organized under Chapter
- 17 841 in similar circumstances. The minimum capital and surplus and
- 18 <u>reserves</u> must be invested in the same character of investments as
- 19 required for a domestic insurance company.
- 20 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 21 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 22 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 23 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
