2	relating to the posting of school district check registers
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 44.0031 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 44.0031. ELECTRONIC CHECKING ACCOUNT TRANSACTION
7	REGISTER. (a) A school district shall maintain the transaction
8	register for the district's checking account in an electronic
9	spreadsheet format in which the transaction register is readily
10	available for purposes of Subsections (b) and (c). The electronic
11	checking account transaction register must include for each check
12	written from a district checking account:
13	(1) the transaction amount;
14	(2) the check number;
15	(3) the name of the person to whom the check was
16	written;
17	(4) the purpose of the expenditure for which the check
18	was written; and
19	(5) the function code assigned to the expenditure for
20	the purpose of meeting state reporting requirements.
21	(b) A school district shall prominently post the electronic
22	checking account transaction register at all times on the
23	district's website for downloading by interested parties.
24	(c) A school district shall transfer data from the

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- 1 <u>electronic checking account transaction register to any interested</u>
- 2 person who requests the data orally or in writing.
- 3 (d) A school district shall update the electronic checking
- 4 account transaction register at least once each month.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 44.0031, Education Code, as added by
- 6 this Act, applies only to a school district checking transaction
- 7 that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A school
- 8 district checking transaction that occurs before the effective date
- 9 of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the transaction
- 10 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 11 purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
