- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 548.001(3), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Conservation commission" means the Texas
- 8 [Natural Resource Conservation] Commission on Environmental
- 9 Quality.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 548.006, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (h) and adding
- 12 Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:
- 13 (a) An advisory committee consisting of nine [six] members
- 14 shall:
- 15 (1) advise the conservation commission and the
- 16 department on the <u>conservation commission's and</u> department's rules
- 17 relating to the operation of the <u>vehicle inspection</u> [emissions
- 18 testing program under this chapter [Subchapter F];
- 19 (2) make recommendations to the conservation
- 20 <u>commission and the</u> department relating to the content of rules
- 21 involving the operation of the <u>vehicle inspection</u> [emissions
- 22 testing | program; and
- 23 (3) perform any other advisory function requested by
- the conservation commission or the department in administering this

- chapter and Chapter 382, Health and Safety Code [Subchapter F].
- 2 (b) The members of the commission shall appoint <u>seven</u>
- 3 [three] members of the committee as follows:
- 4 (1) <u>four persons</u> [<del>one person</del>] to represent inspection
- 5 station owners and operators, with two of those persons from
- 6 counties conducting vehicle emissions testing under Subchapter F
- 7 and two of those persons from counties conducting safety only
- 8 inspections;
- 9 (2) one person to represent manufacturers of motor
- 10 vehicle emissions inspection devices; [and]
- 11 (3) one person to represent independent vehicle
- 12 equipment repair technicians; and
- 13 (4) one person to represent the public interest.
- 14 (c) The [Each member of the conservation commission shall
- 15 appoint one member of the committee. The member appointed by the]
- 16 presiding officer of the conservation commission and the presiding
- 17 officer of the commission shall each appoint one member of the
- 18 <u>committee who will alternate serving</u> [serve] as the presiding
- 19 officer of the committee.
- (h) The committee is entitled to review and comment on rules
- 21 to be considered for adoption by the conservation commission, the
- commission, or the department under this chapter or Chapter 382,
- 23 <u>Health and Safety Code</u>, [Subchapter F] before the rules are adopted
- 24 [published].
- 25 (i) The committee shall hold at least two meetings each
- 26 year.
- 27 (j) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the

- SECTION 3. Section 548.006(h), Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a proposed rule, including a proposed amendment to a rule, first proposed after the first meeting of the advisory committee established under Section 548.006, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
