- 8 <u>(a)</u> A rating plan respecting the writing of <u>automobile</u>
- 9 [motor vehicle] insurance, other than insurance written pursuant to

- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies to an automobile insurance
- 23 policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or

- 1 policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed prior to
- 2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 3 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 4 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
