1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the authority of the State Board of Veterinary Medical
1-10 Examiners to assess certain administrative costs.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Section 801.411 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 801.411. ASSESSMENT OF COSTS. The board may assess a
1-15 person who is found to have violated this chapter the
1-16 administrative costs of conducting a hearing to determine the
1-17 violation.

1-18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-19 to a hearing conducted under Chapter 801, Occupations Code, on or
1-20 after the effective date of this Act. A hearing conducted before
1-21 that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the hearing
1-22 was conducted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
1-23 purpose.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
