## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to participation by private school students in University
3	Interscholastic League sponsored activities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.0831 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.0831. PARTICIPATION BY PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS IN
8	UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE ACTIVITIES. (a) In this section,
9	"private school" has the meaning assigned by Section 39.033(d).
10	(b) The University Interscholastic League may not deny a
11	school or its students the opportunity to participate in an
12	activity sponsored by the league or become a member of an
13	appropriate league district or otherwise discriminate against a
14	private school or its students if the private school:
15	(1) is accredited by an accrediting organization
16	recognized by the agency;
17	(2) offers a four-year high school curriculum;
18	(3) offers interscholastic competition;
19	(4) requires daily student attendance at a specific
20	location; and
21	(5) sought membership in another interscholastic
22	organization but was denied membership in that organization.
23	(c) A private school seeking to participate in a University

- district must apply to the league on a signed form prescribed by the 2 league. The private school must certify its eligibility under this subchapter and league rules in the application and must attach 3
- 4 proof of accreditation. The league may not impose eligibility
- requirements for private schools that exceed the requirements of 5
- 6 this subchapter or league rules for public schools or require proof
- 7 of eligibility that exceeds the proof required of public schools.
- On approval of an application, the league shall issue a certificate 8
- 9 of approval to the applicant school. The application and
- certificate of approval are governmental records for purposes of 10
- Section 37.10, Penal Code. 11
- 12 (d) To determine the appropriate University Interscholastic
- League district in which an eligible private school will 13
- participate, the league must multiply the private school's 14
- 15 enrollment by two and place the private school in an appropriate
- league district based on that enrollment figure, provided that the 16
- 17 private school is placed in a league district not lower than the 2A
- level. 18

- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 19
- 20 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
