A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the imposition of a civil penalty in connection with a 3 self-corrected statement, registration, or report filed with the Texas Ethics Commission. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 571.0771, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read 7 as follows: 8 A statement, registration, or report required that is 9 (a) filed with the commission is not considered to be late for purposes 10 of any applicable civil penalty for late filing of the statement, 11 12 registration, or report if: 13 (1) [the statement, registration, or report as 14 originally filed substantially complies with the applicable law; [(2)] any error or omission in the 15 statement, registration, or report as originally filed was made in good faith; 16 17 and 18 (2) [(3) the person filing the statement, registration, or report files a corrected or amended statement, 19 registration, or report] not later than the 14th business day after 20 the date the person filing the statement, registration, or report 21 learns that the statement, registration, or report as originally 22 23 filed is inaccurate or incomplete, the person files: 24 (A) a corrected or amended statement,

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1	registration, or report; and
2	(B) an affidavit stating that the error or
3	omission in the original statement, registration, or report was
4	made in good faith.
5	(b) <u>Subsection (a)</u> [This section] does not apply to <u>:</u>
6	(1) a penalty imposed under Section 571.069 or
7	Subchapter E or F <u>; or</u>
8	(2) a report required to be filed under Section
9	254.038, 254.039, 254.064(c), 254.124(c), or 254.154(c), Election
10	<u>Code</u> .
11	(c) A report required to be filed under Section 254.064(c),
12	254.124(c), or 254.154(c), Election Code, is not considered to be
13	late for purposes of any applicable civil penalty for late filing of
14	the report if:
15	(1) the report as originally filed substantially
16	complies with the applicable law, as determined by the commission;
17	(2) any error or omission in the report as originally
18	filed was made in good faith; and
19	(3) not later than the 14th business day after the date
20	the person filing the report learns that the report as originally
21	filed is inaccurate or incomplete, the person files:
22	(A) a corrected or amended report; and
23	(B) an affidavit stating that the error or
24	omission in the original report was made in good faith.
25	SECTION 2. Sections 571.0771(b-1) and (b-2), Government
26	Code, are repealed.
27	SECTION 3. Section 571.0771, Government Code, as amended by

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this Act, applies only to a report, registration, or statement required to be filed with the Texas Ethics Commission that is due on or after September 1, 2007. A report, registration, or statement required to be filed with the Texas Ethics Commission that is due before September 1, 2007, is governed by the law in effect on the date the report, registration, or statement is due, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
