9	may not grant a divorce before the 60th day after the date the suit
10	was filed. [A decree rendered in violation of this subsection is
11	not subject to collateral attack.]
12	(c) The court may not grant a divorce on the grounds of
13	insupportability before:
14	(1) the 180th day after the date the suit was filed; or
15	(2) the first anniversary of the date the suit was
16	filed, if the parties to the marriage are the parents of a child
17	under 18 years of age born or adopted during the marriage.
18	(d) A decree rendered in violation of Subsection (a) or (c)
19	is not subject to collateral attack.
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a suit for dissolution of a marriage filed on or after the
22	effective date of this Act. A suit for dissolution of a marriage
23	filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
24	in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is

continued in effect for that purpose.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
