- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 38.004, Education Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) Subject to <u>Subsections (b-1) and [Subsection]</u> (c), the
- 8 Texas Board of Health may modify or delete any of the immunizations
- 9 in Subsection (a) or may require immunizations against additional
- 10 diseases as a requirement for admission to any elementary or
- 11 secondary school.
- 12 (b-1) The governor may not require vaccination against
- human papillomavirus as a condition for admission to any elementary
- 14 or secondary school. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 15 Human Services Commission may not require immunization against
- 16 human papillomavirus under this section. This subsection preempts
- 17 any contrary rule or executive order.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
