  7 BUILDINGS. (a) On direction of the commission's attention to a
- 8 needed improvement or repair of a building or office by the head of
- 9 a department or office, the commission shall provide for and direct
- 10 the repair or improvement.
- 11 (b) The commission shall establish a preventive maintenance
- 12 program and enter into energy savings performance contracts of the
- type described by Section 2166.406(a) covering each state building
- or office for which the commission is responsible for providing
- 15 facility management services under this chapter or other law.
- SECTION 2. Section 2165.057(a), Government Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The commission shall:
- $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  develop and implement policies that clearly define
- 20 the responsibilities of the commission and the commission's staff
- 21 that relate to conducting facilities management services for state
- agency facilities under Section 2165.007;
- 23 (2) with each state agency tenant, enter into a

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- 1 services the commission will provide and any activities related to
- 2 facilities management services the tenant agency and its employees
- 3 will provide at agency cost; and
