1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the preservation, maintenance, and restoration of
- 3 certain state buildings by the Texas Historical Commission and to
- 4 the transfer of the Texas Building and Procurement Commission's
- 5 Governor's Mansion duties to the State Preservation Board.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 442.0072(d), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (d) The commission shall preserve, maintain in a state of
- 10 suitable repair, restore, and develop the church and the house,
- 11 their contents, and their grounds, in the manner determined by the
- 12 commission, for the beautification and cultural enhancement of the
- 13 properties as a significant Texas historical site and in a manner
- 14 consistent with development of the Capitol Complex.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 442.0073 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 442.0073. PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN
- 18 STATE BUILDINGS. (a) The commission shall preserve, maintain, and
- 19 restore Luther Hall, the Elrose Building, and the
- 20 <u>Christianson-Leberman Building, their contents, and their grounds.</u>
- 21 (b) For purposes of this section, Luther Hall and the Elrose
- 22 Building are located on 16th Street between Colorado Street and
- 23 North Congress Avenue in Austin and the Christianson-Leberman
- 24 Building is located at 1304 Colorado Street in Austin.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 2165.007(b), Government Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall
- 4 provide facilities management services in relation to all state
- 5 agency facilities in Travis County or a county adjacent to Travis
- 6 County. The commission's duty does not apply to:
- 7 (1) a facility owned or operated by an institution of
- 8 higher education;
- 9 (2) military facilities;
- 10 (3) facilities owned or operated by the Texas
- 11 Department of Criminal Justice;
- 12 (4) facilities owned or operated by the Texas Youth
- 13 Commission;
- 14 (5) facilities owned or operated by the Texas
- 15 Department of Transportation;
- 16 (6) the Capitol, including the Capitol Extension, the
- 17 General Land Office building, the Bob Bullock Texas State History
- 18 Museum, [and] any museum located on the Capitol grounds, the
- 19 Governor's Mansion, and any property maintained by the Texas
- 20 Historical Commission under Sections 442.0072 and 442.0073;
- 21 (7) a facility determined by the commission to be
- 22 completely residential;
- 23 (8) a regional or field office of a state agency; or
- 24 (9) a facility located within or on state park
- 25 property.
- SECTION 4. On September 1, 2007:
- 27 (1) all powers and duties of the Texas Building and

- 1 Procurement Commission related to the Governor's Mansion and its
- 2 grounds are transferred to the State Preservation Board;
- 3 (2) all records of the Texas Building and Procurement
- 4 Commission related to the Governor's Mansion and its grounds are
- 5 transferred to the State Preservation Board;
- 6 (3) all contracts of the Texas Building and
- 7 Procurement Commission pertaining specifically to the Governor's
- 8 Mansion and its grounds are transferred to the State Preservation
- 9 Board; and
- 10 (4) all appropriations to the Texas Building and
- 11 Procurement Commission specifically for purposes pertaining to the
- 12 Governor's Mansion and its grounds, and all appropriations to the
- 13 Texas Building and Procurement Commission budgeted by the agency
- 14 for expenditures pertaining to the Governor's Mansion and its
- grounds, are transferred to the State Preservation Board.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
