- 2 relating to the preservation, maintenance, and restoration of
- 3 certain state buildings by the State Preservation Board.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 442.0071(e), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The State <u>Preservation Board</u> [<u>Purchasing and General</u>
- 8 Services Commission] and the office of the governor may exercise
- 9 the powers and shall perform the duties relating to the Governor's
- 10 Mansion that are provided by applicable law, subject to the
- 11 requirements of this section.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Section 443.0073 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 443.0073. PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN
- 15 STATE BUILDINGS. (a) The board shall preserve, maintain, and
- 16 restore the Governor's Mansion, the Gethsemane Church and Luther
- 17 Hall, the Elrose Building, the Christianson-Leberman Building, and
- 18 the Carrington-Covert House, their contents, and their grounds,
- 19 subject to the Texas Historical Commission's duties to preserve,
- 20 maintain, and restore the buildings and grounds under other law.
- (b) For purposes of this section, the Gethsemane Church and
- the Carrington-Covert House are the buildings described by Section
- 23 442.0072(c), and Luther Hall and the Elrose Building are located on
- 24 16th Street between Colorado Street and North Congress Avenue in

- 1 Austin and the Christianson-Leberman Building is located at 1304
- 2 Colorado Street in Austin.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 2165.007(b), Government Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall
- 6 provide facilities management services in relation to all state
- 7 agency facilities in Travis County or a county adjacent to Travis
- 8 County. The commission's duty does not apply to:
- 9 (1) a facility owned or operated by an institution of
- 10 higher education;
- 11 (2) military facilities;
- 12 (3) facilities owned or operated by the Texas
- 13 Department of Criminal Justice;
- 14 (4) facilities owned or operated by the Texas Youth
- 15 Commission;
- 16 (5) facilities owned or operated by the Texas
- 17 Department of Transportation;
- 18 (6) the Capitol, including the Capitol Extension, the
- 19 General Land Office building, the Bob Bullock Texas State History
- 20 Museum, [and] any museum located on the Capitol grounds, and any
- 21 property maintained by the State Preservation Board under Section
- 22 443.0073;
- 23 (7) a facility determined by the commission to be
- 24 completely residential;
- 25 (8) a regional or field office of a state agency; or
- 26 (9) a facility located within or on state park
- 27 property.
