A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- relating to the authority to charge reasonable fees for emergency services performed by volunteer fire departments.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 342, Local Government Code, is amended 6 by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER D. CONTRACTS WITH VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS

- 8 <u>Sec. 342.031. FEES FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICES.</u>
- 9 A municipality that contracts with a volunteer fire department for
- 10 the performance of emergency services may charge a reasonable fee
- 11 for the emergency services performed by the department. The fee
- must be paid within a reasonable amount of time established by the
- 13 municipality.

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- 14 SECTION 2. Section 352.001(c), Local Government Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (c) The commissioners court of a county may contract with an
- incorporated volunteer fire department that is located within the
- 18 county to provide fire protection to an area of the county that is
- 19 located outside the municipalities in the county. The court may pay
- 20 for that protection from the general fund of the county. The county
- 21 may charge a reasonable fee for emergency services performed by the
- 22 <u>volunteer fire department under contract with the county. The fee</u>
- 23 must be paid within a reasonable amount of time established by the
- county.

- 1 SECTION 3. Chapter 614, Government Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subchapter H to read as follows:
- 3 SUBCHAPTER H. AUTHORITY OF CERTAIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS TO
- 4 CHARGE FEES FOR SERVICES
- 5 Sec. 614.121. FEES FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICES.
- 6 (a) In this section, "volunteer fire department" has the meaning
- 7 <u>assigned by Section 614.071.</u>
- 8 (b) A volunteer fire department that is not operating under
- 9 a contract with an emergency services district under Chapter 775,
- 10 Health and Safety Code, a county, a municipality, or another
- 11 political subdivision to provide emergency services may directly
- 12 charge a reasonable fee to the persons for whom the department
- 13 performs emergency services.
- 14 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 15 beginning with emergency services performed by a volunteer fire
- department on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
