| 7  | SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 301, Government Code, is         |
| 8  | amended by adding Section 301.035 to read as follows:             |
| 9  | Sec. 301.035. RECORD VOTE ON BILLS AND OTHER MEASURES AND         |
| 10 | ACTIONS REQUIRED. (a) A vote taken by a house or committee of the |
| 11 | <pre>legislature must be by record vote if the vote is on:</pre>  |
| 12 | (1) approval or disapproval of a bill on second or                |
| 13 | third reading or of an amendment or substitute to a bill;         |
| 14 | (2) approval or disapproval of a joint resolution                 |
| 15 | proposing or ratifying a constitutional amendment on second or    |
| 16 | third reading or of an amendment or substitute to such a joint    |
| 17 | resolution;   |
| 18 | (3) the appointment or election of a legislative                  |
| 19 | officer or other public official; or                              |

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Subsection (a) shall be recorded in the journal of the appropriate

house or in the minutes of the appropriate committee.

- 8 (2) permanently maintain that information on the

- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
