- 5 SECTION 1. Section 391.252(a), Transportation Code, as
- 6 amended by Chapters 281, 352, 405, 796, 903, 983, 1046, and 1353,
- 7 Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is reenacted
- 8 and amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) A person may not erect an off-premise sign that is
- 10 adjacent to and visible from:
- 11 (1) U.S. Highway 290 between the western city limits
- 12 of the city of Austin and the eastern city limits of the city of

- 14 (2) State Highway 317 between the northern city limits
- of the city of Belton to the southern city limits of the city of

- 17 (3) State Highway 16 between the northern city limits
- of the city of Kerrville and Interstate Highway 20;
- 19 (4) U.S. Highway 77 between State Highway 186 and
- 20 State Highway 44;
- 21 (5) [U.S. Highway 281 between State Highway 186 and
- 22 Interstate Highway 37, exclusive of the segment of U.S. Highway 281
- 23 located in the city limits of Three Rivers;

- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 394, Transportation Code,

- 17 Sec. 394.0225. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT PROHIBITED. The
- 18 commission may not issue a permit under this chapter for an
- 19 off-premise sign adjacent to and visible from County Road 170 in
- 20 Hays County.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
