## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to providing notice to the Department of Family and

Protective Services of investigations of family violence at certain

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Article 5.04, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

7 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

- 8 <u>(a-1)</u> A peace officer who investigates a family violence
- 9 allegation or who responds to a disturbance call that may involve
- 10 family violence shall determine whether the address of the persons
- involved in the allegation or call matches the address of a current
- 12 licensed foster home or verified agency foster home listed in the
- 13 <u>Texas Crime Information Center.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Article 5.05, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 <u>(a-1)</u> In addition to the written report required under
- 18 Subsection (a), a peace officer who investigates a family violence
- 19 <u>incident or who responds to a disturbance call that may involve</u>
- 20 <u>family violence shall make a report to the Department of Family and</u>
- 21 Protective Services if the location of the incident or call, or the
- 22 known address of a person involved in the incident or call, matches
- 23 the address of a current licensed foster home or a verified agency
- 24 <u>foster home as listed in the Texas Crime Information Center.</u> The

- 1 report under this subsection may be made orally or electronically
- 2 and must:
- 3 (1) include the information required by Subsection
- 4 (a); and
- 5 (2) be filed with the Department of Family and
- 6 Protective Services within 24 hours of the beginning of the
- 7 investigation or receipt of the disturbance call.
- 8 (b) Each local law enforcement agency shall establish a
- 9 departmental code for identifying and retrieving family violence
- 10 reports as outlined in Subsection (a) of this section. A district
- 11 or county attorney or an assistant district or county attorney
- 12 exercising authority in the county where the law enforcement agency
- 13 maintains records under this section is entitled to access to the
- 14 records. The Department of Family and Protective Services is
- entitled to access the records relating to any person who is 14
- 16 years of age or older and who resides in a licensed foster home or a
- 17 verified agency foster home.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 19 is amended by adding Sections 42.0448 and 42.0449 to read as
- 20 follows:
- Sec. 42.0448. NOTIFICATION OF FAMILY VIOLENCE CALLS. The
- 22 department shall notify a child-placing agency of each family
- violence report the department receives under Article 5.05, Code of
- 24 Criminal Procedure, that:
- 25 (1) occurred at an agency foster home verified by the
- 26 child-placing agency; or
- 27 (2) involves a person who resides at an agency foster

- 1 home verified by the child-placing agency.
- 2 Sec. 42.0449. REQUIRED ACTIONS AFTER NOTICE OF FAMILY
- 3 <u>VIOLENCE CALL.</u> The executive commissioner shall adopt rules
- 4 specifying the actions that the department, an independent foster
- 5 home, and a child-placing agency shall take after receiving notice
- 6 of a family violence report under Article 5.05, Code of Criminal
- 7 Procedure, or Section 42.0448 to ensure the health, safety, and
- 8 welfare of each child residing in the licensed foster home or
- 9 verified agency foster home.
- SECTION 4. Section 42.045, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 12 (d) An independent foster home and a child-placing agency
- shall notify the department of any change of address for a licensed
- 14 <u>foster home or a verified agency foster</u> home. The independent
- 15 <u>foster home and child-placing agency shall notify the department of</u>
- 16 the address change within the earlier of two business days or 72
- 17 hours of the date the foster home changes its address.
- SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- is amended by adding Section 42.0451 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.0451. DATABASE OF FOSTER HOMES; INFORMATION
- 21 PROVIDED TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) The department shall
- 22 <u>maintain a database of licensed foster homes and verified agency</u>
- 23 foster homes including the current address for each licensed or
- verified home as reported to the department. The database must be
- 25 updated on a regular basis.
- 26 (b) The department shall make the database available to the
- 27 Department of Public Safety for the purposes of Subsection (c).

- 1 (c) The Department of Public Safety shall include the
  2 information provided under Subsection (b) in the Texas Crime
  3 Information Center database and establish a procedure by which a
  4 peace officer or employee of a law enforcement agency who provides
  5 the department with a street address is automatically provided
  6 information as to whether the address is licensed as a foster home
  7 or verified as an agency foster home under this chapter.
- 8 (d) Information provided to the Department of Public Safety
  9 under this section is confidential and not subject to disclosure
  10 under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 11 SECTION 6. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code, 12 is amended by adding Section 42.0561 to read as follows:

- Sec. 42.0561. INFORMATION RELATING TO FAMILY VIOLENCE REPORTS. Before the department may issue a license or registration for a foster home or a child-placing agency may issue a verification certificate for an agency foster home, the department or child-placing agency must obtain information relating to each family violence report at the applicant's residence to which a law enforcement agency responded during the 12 months preceding the date of the application. The applicant shall provide the information on a form prescribed by the department.
- SECTION 7. The Department of Family and Protective Services shall establish the database and a method for exchanging information required by Section 42.0451, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act, not later than September 1, 2008.
- 26 SECTION 8. Section 42.0561, Human Resources Code, as added 27 by this Act, applies to an application for a license, registration,

- 1 or certificate made on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 2 application made before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 3 by the law in effect on the date the application was made, and the
- 4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
