## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to judges and stewards employed by the Texas Racing
- 3 Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3.07, Texas Racing Act (Article 179e,
- 6 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by amending Subsection
- 7 (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) [The commission shall employ all of the judges and all 9 of the stewards for the supervision of a horse race or greyhound
- 10 race meeting. Each horse race or greyhound race meeting shall be
- 11 supervised by three stewards for horse racing or by three judges for
- 12 greyhound racing. The commission shall designate one of the
- 13 stewards or judges as the presiding steward or judge for each race
- 14 meeting. The commission shall employ two of the judges and two of
- 15 the stewards. The association shall appoint the third judge or
- 16 <u>steward</u>, as appropriate. The association, following the completion
- of the race meeting, may submit written comments to the commission
- 18 regarding the job performance of the stewards and judges for the
- 19 commission's review. Comments received are not binding, in any way,
- 20 on the commission. For each race meeting, the commission shall
- 21 employ at least one state veterinarian. The commission may, by
- 22 rule, impose a fee on an association to offset the costs of
- 23 compensating the stewards, judges, and state veterinarians. The
- 24 amount of the fee for the compensation of stewards, judges, and

- 1 state veterinarians must be reasonable according to industry
- 2 standards for the compensation of those officials at other
- 3 racetracks and may not exceed the actual cost to the commission for
- 4 compensating the officials. All other racetrack officials shall be
- 5 appointed by the association, with the approval of the commission.
- 6 Compensation for those officials not compensated by the commission
- 7 shall be determined by the association.
- 8 <u>(a-1) Section 6.16 of this Act does not prohibit an</u>
- 9 association from employing a person described by Section 6.16(a) as
- 10 <u>a judge or steward if the person was employed by the commission on</u>
- 11 September 1, 2007. This subsection expires September 1, 2010.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
