## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 382.0275(b), Health and Safety Code, is

6 amended to read as follows:

- The commission may not adopt or enforce a rule, 7 (b) determination, or order limiting emissions from residential water 8 heaters to less than 40 nanograms of nitrogen oxides per joule 9 unless a lower limit is established by a federal statute or rule. 10 [The commission shall direct the executive director to perform a 11 study, to be completed by December 31, 2005, regarding the 12 technical and economic feasibility of regulating residential water 13 If the executive director's study shows that regulation 14 of residential water heaters is technically or economically 15 infeasible, the executive director shall recommend to the 16 17 commission that the rules concerning water heaters be repealed not
- 18 later than December 31, 2006, and shall propose emission reductions
- 19 to offset the loss of state implementation plan credits from the
- 20 rules. The commission shall provide notice of and hold a public
- 21 hearing on the study.
- SECTION 2. Section 382.0275(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 23 repealed.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
