3	Quality to regulate emissions from residential water heaters.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 382.0275(b) and (c), Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(b) <u>The commission may not adopt or enforce a rule,</u>
8	determination, or order limiting emissions from residential water
9	heaters to less than 40 nanograms of nitrogen oxides per joule
10	unless a lower limit is established by a federal statute or rule.
11	[The commission shall direct the executive director to perform a
12	study, to be completed by December 31, 2005, regarding the
13	technical and economic feasibility of regulating residential water
14	heaters. If the executive director's study shows that regulation
15	of residential water heaters is technically or economically
16	infeasible, the executive director shall recommend to the
17	commission that the rules concerning water heaters be repealed not
18	later than December 31, 2006, and shall propose emission reductions
19	to offset the loss of state implementation plan credits from the
20	rules. The commission shall provide notice of and hold a public
21	hearing on the study.]
22	[(c) Any emission reductions related to residential gas
23	water heaters that the commission does not adopt because of
24	Subsection (b) shall be replaced by a requirement that will obtain

1 emission reductions from the same category.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
