A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to who is a dependent for the purposes of the Texas
 3 Employees Group Benefits Act.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1551.004(a), Insurance Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In this chapter, "dependent" with respect to an 8 individual eligible to participate in the group benefits program
- 10 (1) spouse;
- 11 (2) unmarried child younger than 25 years of age;

under Section 1551.101 or 1551.102 means the individual's:

- 12 (3) child of any age who the board of trustees 13 determines lives with or has the child's care provided by the 14 individual on a regular basis if:
- 15 (A) the child is mentally retarded or physically 16 incapacitated to the extent that the child is dependent on the
- 17 individual for care or support, as determined by the board of
- 18 trustees;

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- 19 (B) the child's coverage under this chapter has
- 20 not lapsed; and
- (C) the child is at least 25 years old and was
- 22 enrolled as a participant in the health benefits coverage under the
- 23 group benefits program on the date of the child's 25th birthday;
- 24 [and]

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1 (4) child of any age who is unmarried, for purposes of 2 health benefit coverage under this chapter, on expiration of the child's continuation coverage under the Consolidated Omnibus 3 4 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (Pub. L. No. 99-272) and its subsequent amendments; and 5 6 (5) parent who: (A) <u>is at least 62 years of age;</u> 7 8 (B) lives with the individual on a regular basis; 9 and (C) is not eligible for Medicaid or any group 10 11 health benefit plan, other than the Texas Health Insurance Risk Pool, regardless of the parent's eligibility for social security 12 benefits. 13

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
